CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS

SHIRTS•

Polo style shirt with collar and sleeves

Solid Colors Only: Yellow, White, or Hunter Green.

- **Phillis Wheatley** Logo is optional
- Must not be excessively long
- Must cover the mid-section and navel area
- School issued club and athletic shirts (must be school colors and have

PANTS

Phillis Wheatley/Hornets logo

Fitted long pants (worn at the waist)

Solid Colors Only: Khaki or Hunter Green

- May not have patches, holes, designs, embroidery or embellishments
- NO shorts, sweatpants, tights or leggings

SKIRTS

Must fall 2” below the knee

Solid Colors Only: Khaki, or Hunter Green.

- May not have patches, holes, designs, embroidery or embellishments

UNDERSHIRTS

Solid Colors Only: Yellow, Hunter Green or White

- Cannot exceed the length of the uniform shirt

OUTERWEAR

Sweatshirts, jackets, and sweaters, senior jerseys worn over school uniform

Solid Colors Only: Yellow, White, or Hunter Green.

- Regulation polo shirt must be worn underneath jackets, sweaters, sweatshirts and senior jerseys.

SHOES

STUDENT ID

Shoes must have backs

Must be worn on lanyard around the neck at all times
